

- their communication and language through fun activities
- On average children make 6 months progress in their communication and language over the 10 weeks.
- It is taught by one of the Nursery adults three times a week for ten weeks in a small group
- Involves partnership with parents- research shows by working together we can maximise your children's progress

- Praise good listening
- "You listened so carefully when I was reading the story."


"Thank you for listening and helping me."

Never rush; remember to pause


