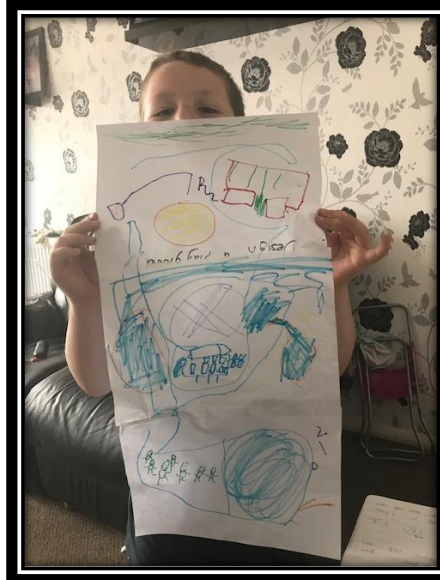


Communication

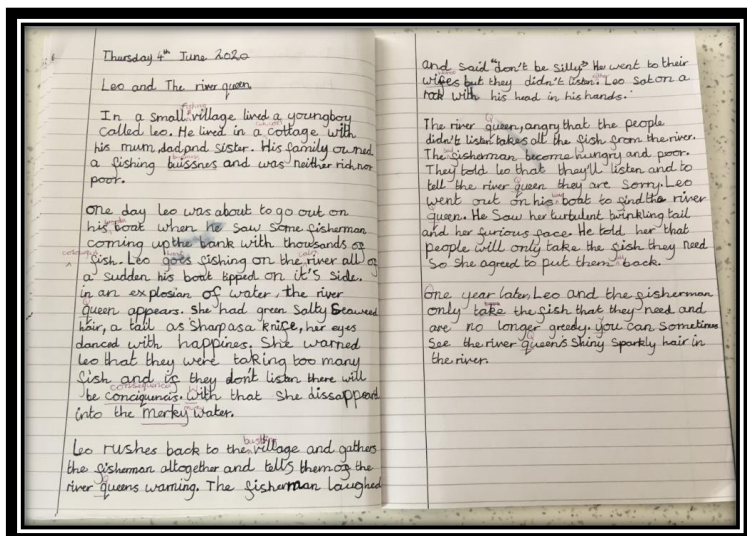

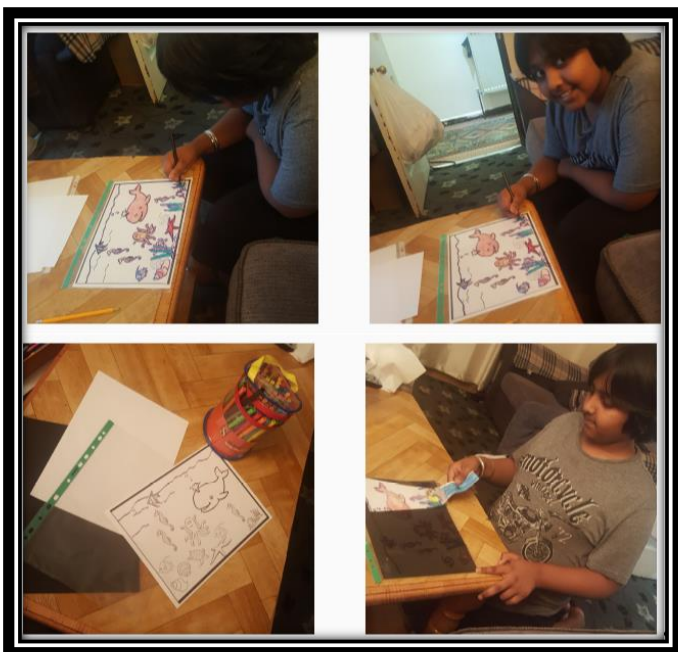
