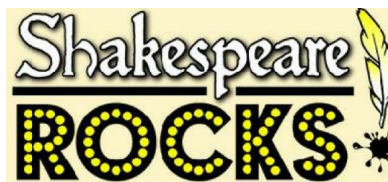
ICE Thursdays
