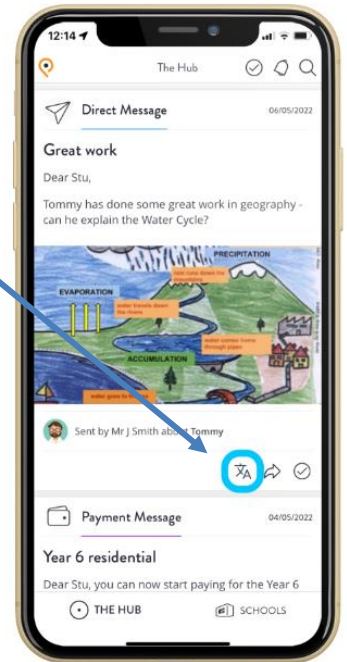
How to translate messages in the Parent Hub app (guidance for schools)

We are taking the opportunity to bring our parent/carers community together once more to celebrate Eid Mubarak.

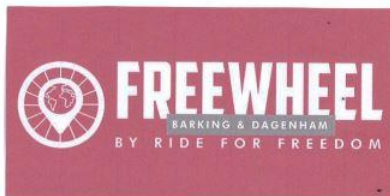

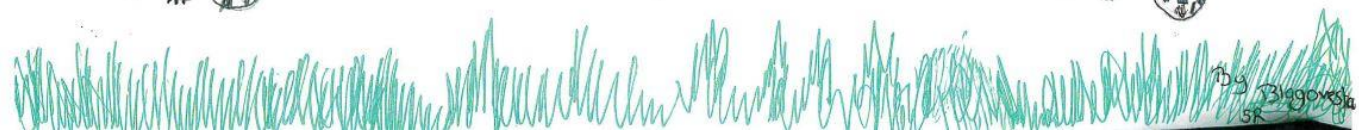
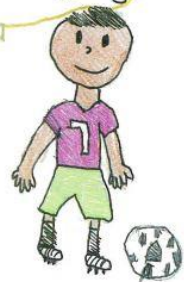

WHO WE ARE

Our Youth Workers are on hand to inspire young people to lead healthier and more positive lives, raising their aspirations to become happy, caring, and responsible citizens with more to offer themselves, their families, the community and employers. Every member gets to learn, develop, and grow with us and harness their skills and talents doing what they enjoy doing the most. With over 20 activities on offer 7 days a week, from boxing and climbing to cooking and dancing, there really is something for everyone.

Junior club (aged 8-12) is open Wednesday 4pm-8pm Saturday 10am-2pm Sunday 3pm-7pm.	Senior (aged 13 - 19) is open Wednesday 4pm-8pm Saturday 10am-2pm Sunday 3pm-7pm.
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Future Youth Zone provides and caters for young people with a range of additional needs up to the age of 25.

Our Futurebility sessions, are Sunday between 10am and 2pm.

£5 per year + 50p per visit

From 13 June 2022 we will be making it safer for our children to get to **Hunters Hall Primary School**



From Monday 13 June 2022 the council intends to introduce a School Street at Hunters Hall Primary School to reduce traffic and improve road safety at pick up and drop off times.

The plans will make part of Alibon Road and Rockwell Road outside the school a pedestrian and cycle-only zone from the hours of **8am to 9.15am** and **2.45pm to 4pm** during term time.

Our aim is to transform the busy, congested and polluted road outside the school gate into a safer, healthier and more pleasant environment, and reduce the nuisance caused to local residents during the school run. We will operate the School Street for an initial 12 month period.

We are also working with children and parents to encourage walking, cycling and scooting to school. We would welcome your support with this so that everyone in the area can enjoy the benefits of quieter, safer roads.

Who is exempt?

No vehicles will be allowed into the school street zone during operating hours unless they have an exemption. Emergency services vehicles are automatically exempt.

Otherwise, you can apply for an exemption only if:

- you are a resident living within the School Street zone, or if you run a business within the zone
- you are a blue badge holder who requires immediate and regular access to the school
- you are a carer of a resident living within the zone, or you are a carer of a disabled or SEN child attending the school who needs to be dropped outside the school entrance, or
- you are a member of school staff.

Children are exposed to up to **five times** higher pollution levels at the school gates



School run traffic accounts for **1 in 4 cars** on the road at peak times

40% of fatal road accidents involving children happen during school run hours



Pollution levels are often **higher** inside the car than outside



Half of local children do less than the recommended **30 minutes** of physical activity a day



The average school trip is **1km**



1,000 children a month are injured on school roads
