Year 2 London visits



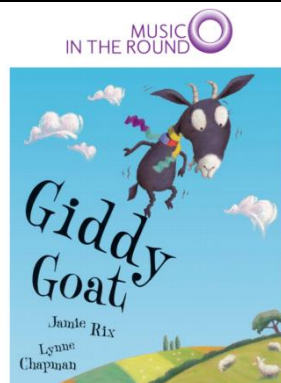
