On Sunday 21st and Monday 22nd July, it was with great pride and pleasure that Hunters Hall Primary School can lay claim to being part of the first Cbeebies Children's Choir, consisting of nearly 400 voices, and singing within the prestigious Royal Albert Hall to an audience of over 5000. The theme set for the 2019 Cbeebies Prom was, "A Musical Journey to the Moon," produced to commemorate and celebrate fifty years since Neil Armstrong first set foot on Earth's only natural satellite.

During this historic musical event, the choir, who was accompanied by Europe's first Black and Minority Ethnic Orchestra: Chineke! and their conductor Kwamé Ryan, performed a brand-new work by Hans Zimmer – which

was the centrepiece of the Prom. In addition to this epic choral symphony, the choir and orchestra performed other well-known classics such as; John Adams' - Short Ride in a Fast Machine; Giacomo Puccini's - Madam Butterfly – Humming Chorus and Benjamin Britten's - The Young Person's Guide to the Orchestra. Of course it would not have been a Cbeebies Prom without ending with a medley of well-known Cbeebies soundtracks led by Justin Fletcher, Yolanda Brown, Maddie Moate and other Cbeebies favourites.

On behalf of our school, we would like to acknowledge Mrs Bright, our music and choir teacher, who arranged for twenty-one of our senior choir to take part alongside choirs from William Ford Junior, Monteagle and Marsh Green Primaries – really putting Barking & Dagenham at the forefront of melodic talent.
