Transition to Secondary School 2019

Moving to secondary school in September 2019 If your child was born between 01 September 2007 and 31 August 2008

This move is not an automatic process. You will need to apply online for a place at the secondary schools you would like your child to go to if they were born between the dates shown above.

Apply online from 1 September 2018 and the closing date for all applications is 31 October 2018.

Speeches begin at 7pm and admission officers will be available afterwards to answer questions you may have about the admissions process.
