It is when we work in partnership together that our children benefit most. We endeavour to support you in any way we can to help with matters of learning, safeguarding and wellbeing.

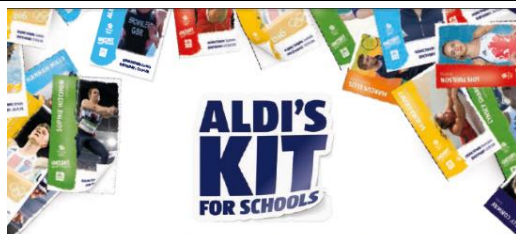
