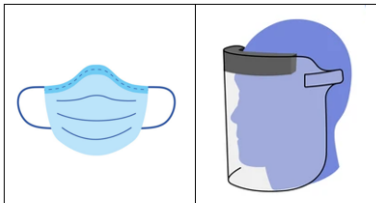

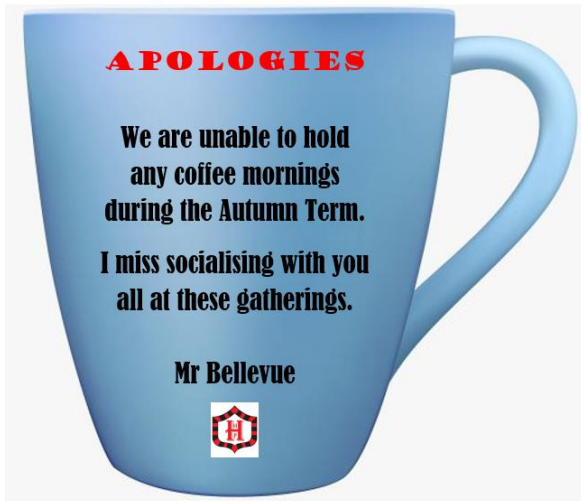

Dear Parent/Carer,

Thank you to all adults who have embraced our new request from the Director of Public Health and worn face coverings on the school premises.

Head Lice

Several cases of head lice have been identified across the school and we wanted to make sure you were kept informed.

Whilst lice are nothing more than a nuisance, it is important that children are checked on a weekly basis so that any head lice can be dealt with quickly and before they are allowed to spread.

Please check your child's hair and treat if any eggs or lice are found. Keep long hair tied back for school.

FOUR STEPS TO LICE-FREE LIFE:



1: INSPECT
If you suspect head lice, check



2: TREAT
Use lice treatment product as directed.



3: REMOVE
lice/nits by combing the hair with the comb provided.



4: CLEAN
home and personal items.
