## Year 2 Fairy Tales Launch

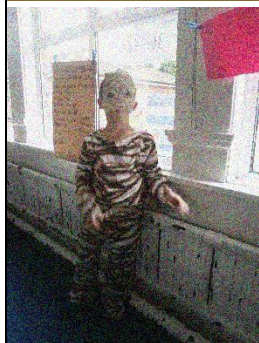
