<https://roadsafetymagic.com/> visited our school with the simple, but important message to: Stop; Look; Listen and Think when near a road. We cannot reiterate enough about keeping safe when out and about.

Some of you will know that at the end of every academic year one of our trophies, "The Tony Black Cup" is given to a year 3 child. The cup was given to the school by the parents of Tony Black, an 8-year-old pupil who lost his life due to a tragic road accident on 26<sup>th</sup> April over thirty-five years ago.

With 2022 data still showing that, "9-15 year olds are statistically more likely to be injured on roads," the importance of educating our young people about staying safe remains paramount.

After a very successful Enterprise Week, our Year 6 pupils would like to thank everybody for their support. Equally, we would like to thank them and our Year 6 teaching staff.

Mrs Hobday, Assistant Headteacher, stated, "...how lovely it has been to see the enterprising side of our year 6 children this week. From the car washing to the breakfast cafe and the fayre yesterday, they have demonstrated a whole new skill set. We have makers and bakers and wheeler-dealers in our midst and their reward trip will be all the sweeter for earning the money for it themselves... Thinking of the whole child is something we are all very good at in our school and it was evident in the children yesterday..."

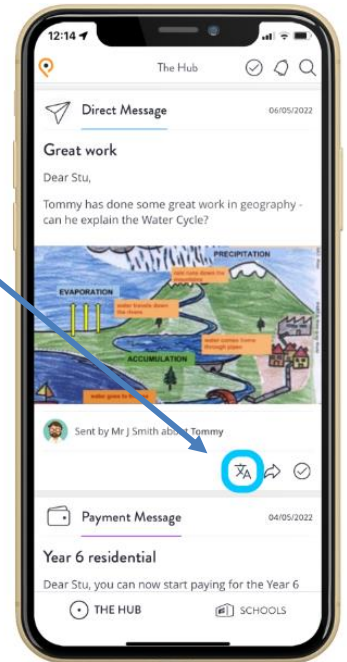

From 13 June 2022 we will be making it safer for our children to get to **Hunters Hall Primary School**



**BeFirst** Working in partnership **Barking & Dagenham**



From Monday 13 June 2022 the council intends to introduce a School Street at Hunters Hall Primary School to reduce traffic and improve road safety at pick up and drop off times.

The plans will make part of Alibon Road and Rockwell Road outside the school a pedestrian and cycle-only zone from the hours of **8am to 9.15am** and **2.45pm to 4pm** during term time.

Our aim is to transform the busy, congested and polluted road outside the school gate into a safer, healthier and more pleasant environment, and reduce the nuisance caused to local residents during the school run. We will operate the School Street for an initial 12 month period.

We are also working with children and parents to encourage walking, cycling and scooting to school. We would welcome your support with this so that everyone in the area can enjoy the benefits of quieter, safer roads.

**Who is exempt?**

No vehicles will be allowed into the school street zone during operating hours unless they have an exemption. Emergency services vehicles are automatically exempt.

Otherwise, you can apply for an exemption only if:

- you are a resident living within the School Street zone, or if you run a business within the zone
- you are a blue badge holder who requires immediate and regular access to the school
- you are a carer of a resident living within the zone, or you are a carer of a disabled or SEN child attending the school who needs to be dropped outside the school entrance, or
- you are a member of school staff.

Anyone who drives through the School Street zone without a permit may be liable to a penalty charge notice.

Children are exposed to up to **five times** higher pollution levels at the school gates



School run traffic accounts for **1 in 4 cars** on the road at peak times

**40%** of fatal road accidents involving children happen during school run hours



Pollution levels are often **higher** inside the car than outside



Half of local children do less than the recommended **30 minutes** of physical activity a day



The average school trip is **1km**



**1,000** children a month are injured on school roads
