
On Friday 10th September, characters from traditional tales took over Year 2 as the year group launched their Fairy Tales topic.



Build the Change



The LEGO Group is asking kids to get involved with big picture issues in its latest sustainability campaign.

Build the Change tasks young builders with tackling tough environmental issues through bricks, coming up with solutions for global problems. It's centred around an online challenge for seven- to 12year-olds, presented by minifigure guides Linda and Leo.

The activity kicks off by asking kids which environmental issues they're most concerned about. They'll then have to let Linda and Leo know how they feel about those problems.



It all leads in to Build the Change's "Big Challenge", which involves kids using their bricks (or whatever creative materials they've managed to find) to build something that could help wild animals overcome challenges wrought by climate change. Once they've assembled their idea, they can then photograph it and share it with the world on LEGO.com.

Finally, children will be encouraged to compose three instructions which they would give world leaders to protect our planet from climate change.

- The Theory Lab A look at the science behind musical theory, this week we examine 'duration', learning all about how different musical notes can vary in length.
- Vocal Zone Breath control is such an important part of singing. The children will explore how breathing impacts things like your pitching, and we'll learn some exercises to help improve our breathing technique.
- Musical Word of the Week 'Technique' is this week's word. We'll focus on what it means in relation to music and highlight some examples of musical techniques that musicians spend years trying to perfect.
