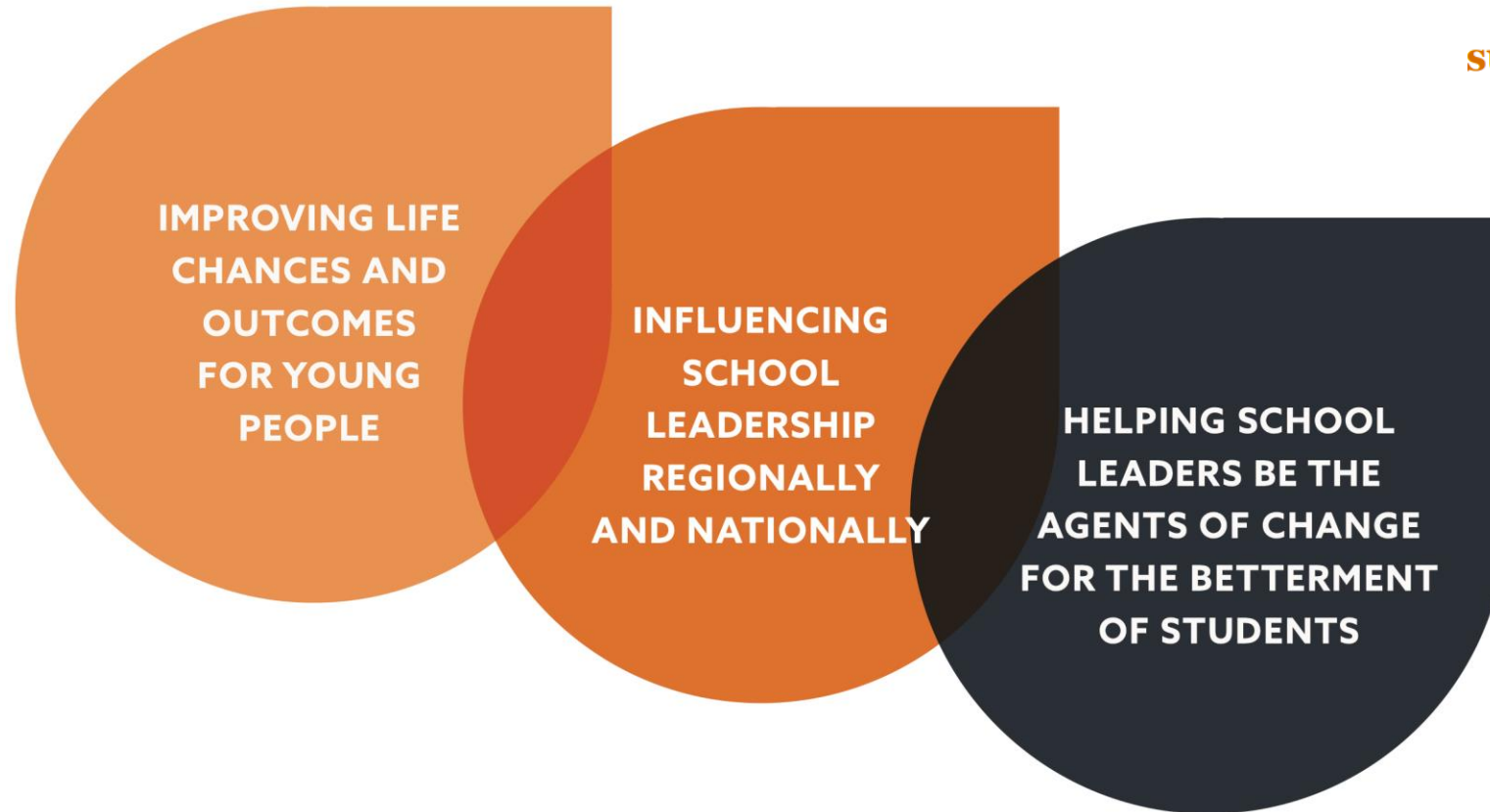

How does PiXL do it?

Networking: PiXL provides a personalised approach to supporting schools. This includes: having a dedicated school associate, national and regional networking events for leaders at all levels, and dedicated MAT Connect associates for MATs.

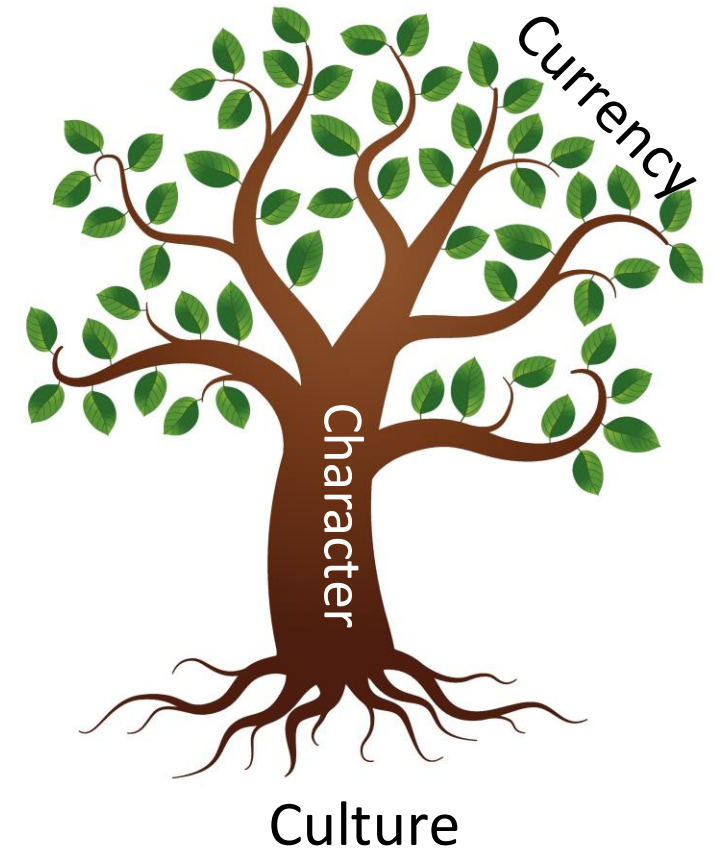
Development: High quality CPD materials to support school leaders and teachers. This includes: national and school-based programmes supporting leadership development, and a library of CPD webinars for subject leads and teachers.

Events: Live events which are digitally streamed and on-demand, to inform, encourage and inspire. This includes: 5 Primary National Conferences each year, a leadership festival for schools and MATs, and special events with high profile speakers.

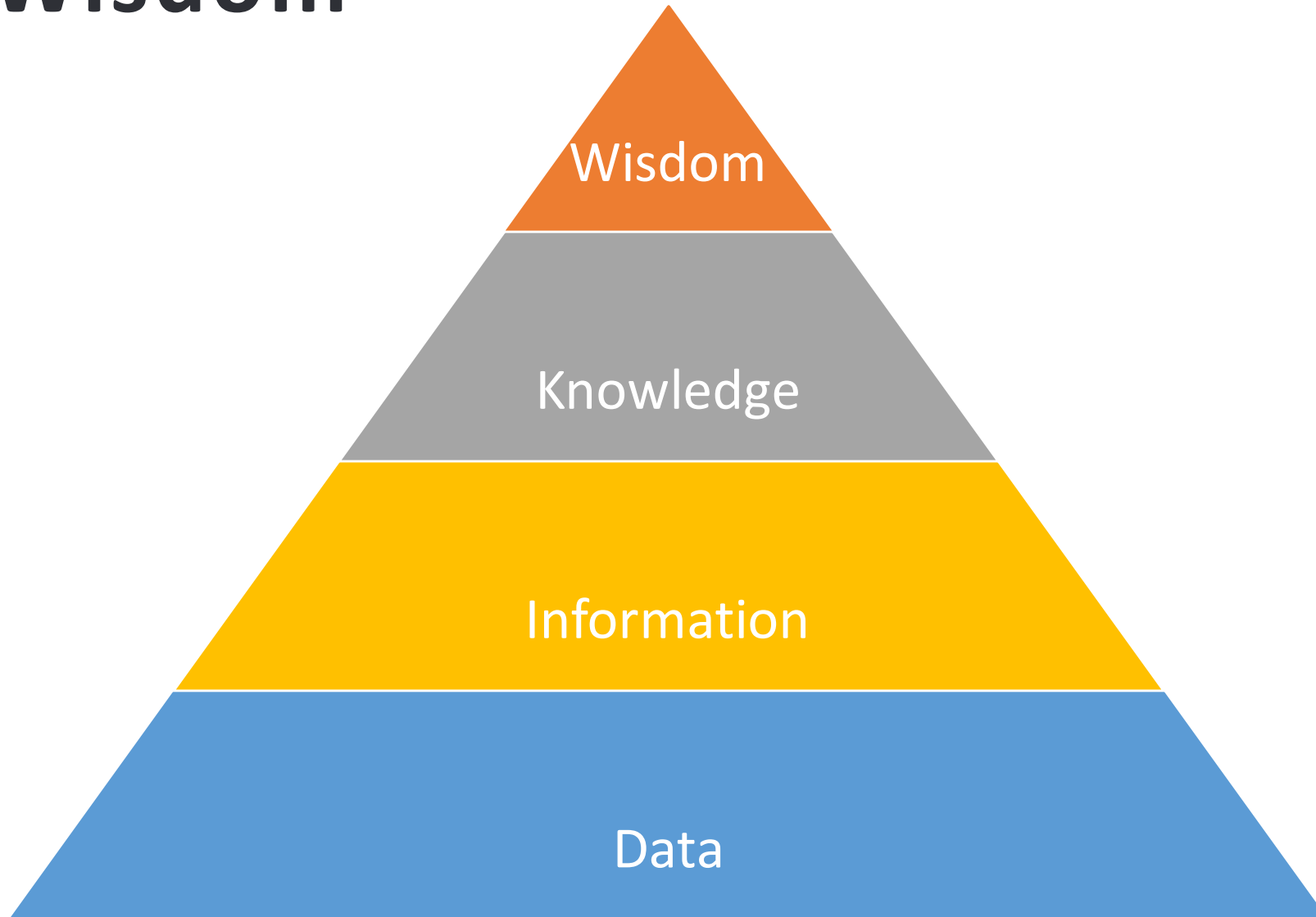
Strategies: PiXL provides diagnostic tools, strategies and resources through their digital platform. This includes: Diagnosis, Therapy, Testing and Revisiting for improving pupil outcomes, assessment, character and life skills development, and developing an awareness of culture through programmes including, 'A Mind to be Kind'.

- Culture: social behaviour



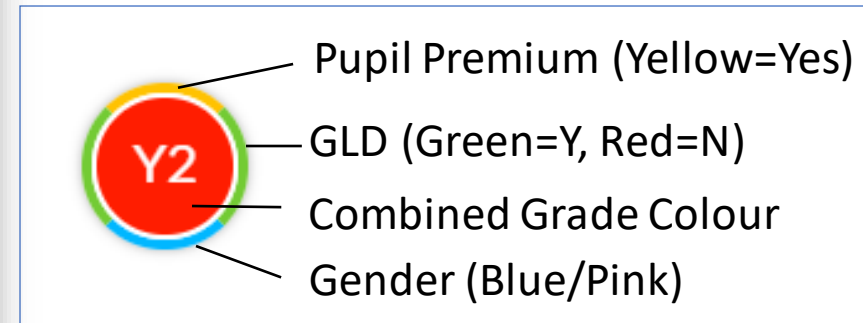
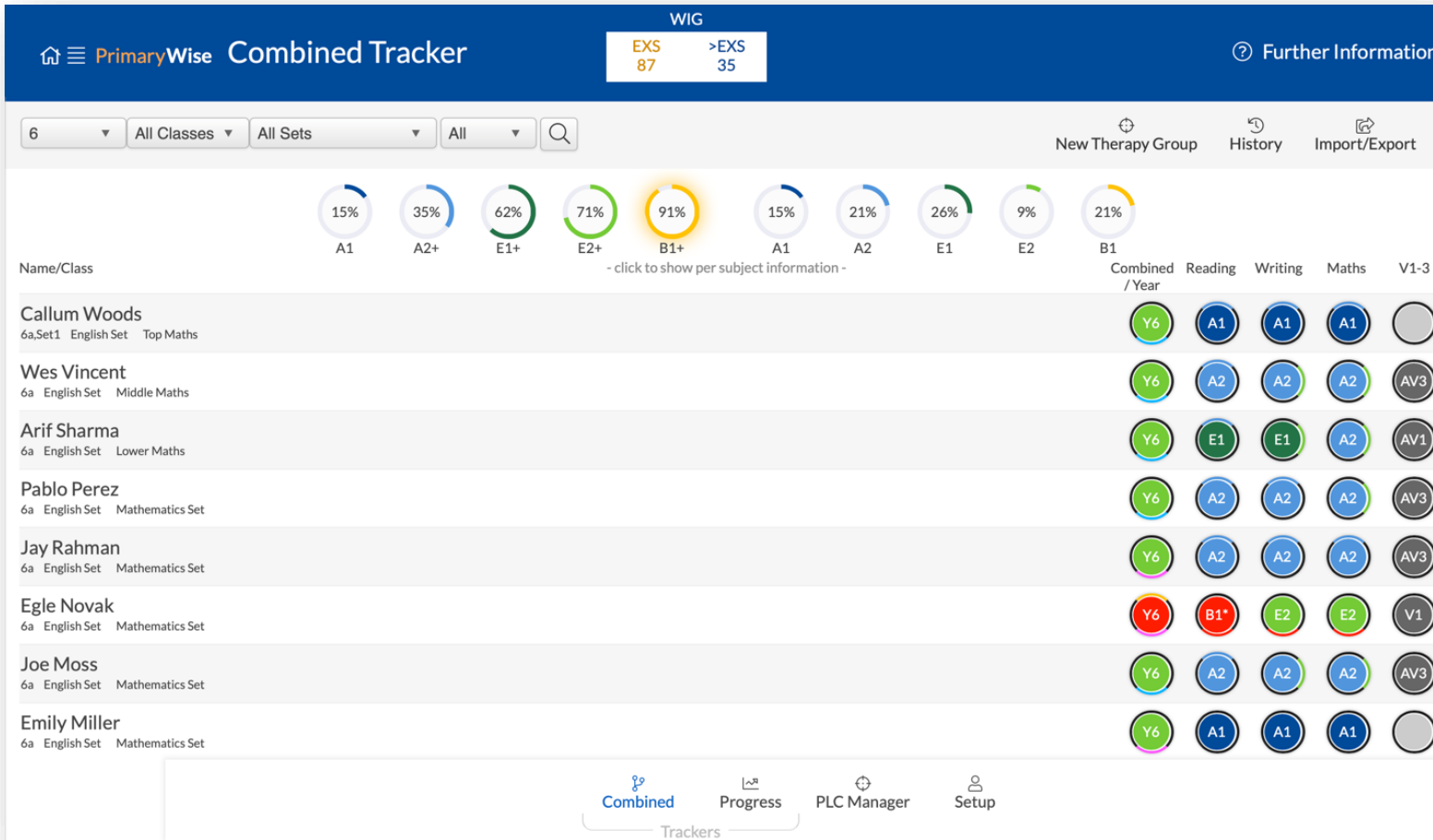

PiXL Language of Assessment

	Based on current rate of progress, will secure Above Expected Standard.
	Above Expected Key Marginal Based on current rate of progress, will securely achieve Expected Standard. With the right forensic support, has the potential to achieve Above Expected Standard.
	Based on current rate of progress, will secure Expected Standard.
	Based on current rate of progress, is likely to achieve Expected Standard but may require some additional support.
	PiXL Key Marginal Based on current rate of progress, will not achieve Expected Standard but with the right forensic support, has the potential to do so.
	Years 1 to 5: Requires specialist support. Year 6: Not expected to achieve Expected Standard.

PiXL Combined Tracker

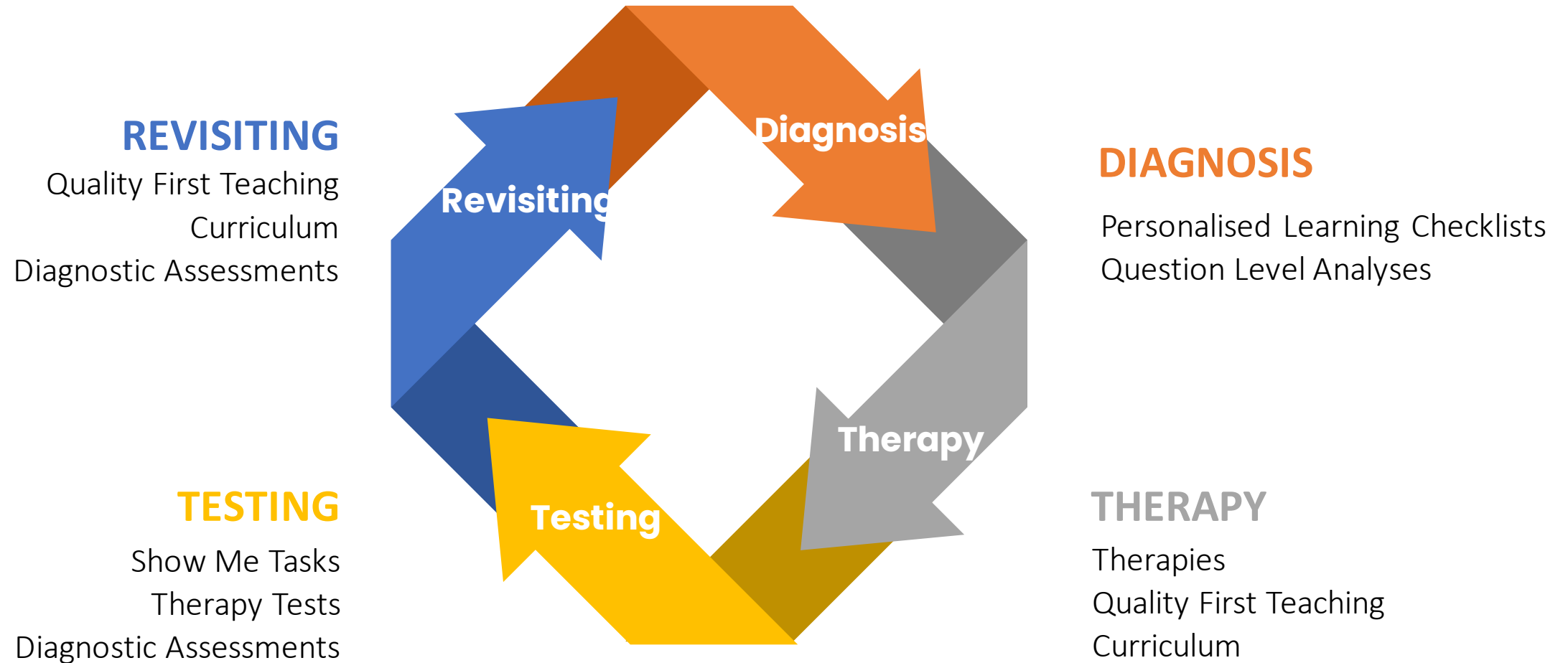


Wildly Important Goal (WIG)

- Can be externally verified at the end of a key stage
- Follows the formula: *'VERB XXX from X to X by when'*

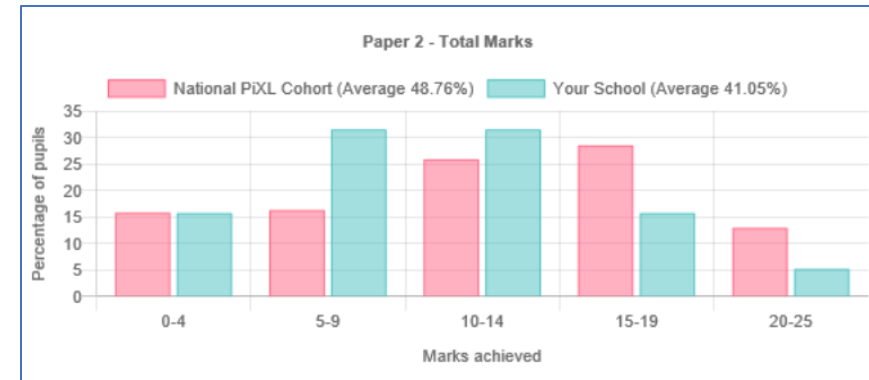
E.g., Increase XXX from % to % by June 2022.
