SYMPTOMS	COVID-19	COLD	FLU
	Symptoms range from mild to severe	Gradual onset of symptoms	Abrupt onset of symptoms
<b>Fever</b>	Common	Rare	Common
<b>Cough</b>	Common (usually dry)	Mild	Common (usually dry)
<b>Sore Throat</b>	Sometimes	Common	Sometimes
<b>Shortness of Breath</b>	Sometimes	No	No
<b>Fatigue</b>	Sometimes	Sometimes	Common
<b>Aches &amp; Pains</b>	Sometimes	Common	Common
<b>Headaches</b>	Sometimes	Rare	Common
<b>Runny or Stuffy Nose</b>	Rare	Common	Sometimes
<b>Diarrhea</b>	Rare	No	Sometimes for children
<b>Sneezing</b>	No	Common	No

If you're struggling to pay your bills or want to make your money stretch a little bit further, join the Community Food Club to reduce your food shopping bill. By paying £18 per month or £3.50 per visit, you will have access to roughly £20 worth of groceries each week.

Your three month membership will also give you access to support from a wide range of services, providing advice on finances, housing, employability and health.

#### WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW

- You must live in London Borough of Barking and Dagenham and be in need of support
- Membership access is available for one person per household to visit once a week
- Membership access is restricted to one site over the course of the 3 month membership
- Members must commit to making a positive lifestyle change over the course of their membership
