### Reading Cafe



have created cardboard tube characters; decorated white t-shirts and have taken part in a multitude of book related activities.




## Soccability

Learning to write is a gradual process. At first, children's writing is just mark-making, but as time passes and they begin to learn the alphabet, they'll begin to make letter shapes, often starting with the letters in their name.

Talking is the basis for all writing in the EYFS. Children don't have the necessary skills to write everything down, so what they say is a precursor to their writing. Remember, you can't write a sentence unless you can say it.
