Thank you for volunteering to support Hunters Hall Primary School. Please read the following guidelines.

Attendance

You must sign in and out of the school using the sign-in sheet in the Reception. Please remember to wear the visitor badge clearly.

If you are unable to attend; contact the school before 8:00am, leaving a message for the class teacher.

Behaviour

You are a role model and therefore are required to set the right example to our pupils and staff. We expect you to go to your assigned class at all times.

If you have a child/ children/ family member in the school, you must follow school policy and not misuse your volunteer status by displaying any favouritism.

Safeguarding

All volunteers require a Disclosure & Barring check (DBS formerly CRB). We will record the reference number along with any photo I.D. Confidentiality

Remember to remain professional at all times. School matters should not be passed on or discussed out of the school environment with friends and family.

Working with children
