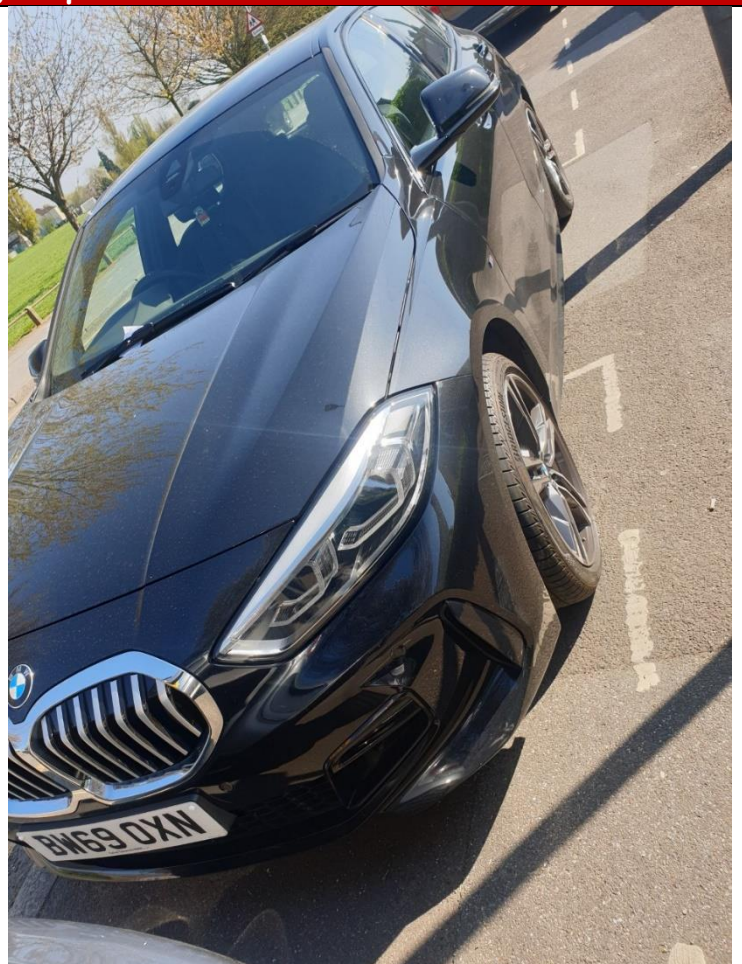
## Parking Request

I took a photograph of the black BMW, registration BW69OXN, to show how they had parked illegally and irresponsibly.

I know it is not your responsibility and I wish adults were as well trained as some children but I'm hoping that you will make them a bit more aware that their selfish actions sometimes has an impact on other people's lives."

# Swimmers shine on county stage



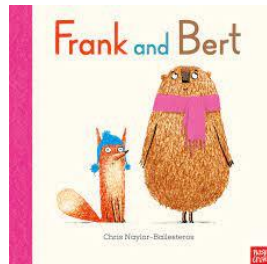
Barking & Dagenham Aquatics face the camera at the Essex Championships.

A team of 30-plus swimmers participated from B&D, led by head coach Kevin Ayres and including children aged between 8 and 18 years old. And Barking & Dagenham walked

away from the competition with multiple medal and flag winners, highlighting the dedication and hard work of swimmers and coaches over the year. David Neacsu finished as Top Male in his age group as B&D finished in a respectable 11th position overall from a strong field of 29 teams. "Barking & Dagenham Aquatics Club are one of number of competing swimming clubs in the area, extremely proud of all swimmers and continue to provide a fun and happy environment for children to progress in swimming," said a spokesperson.

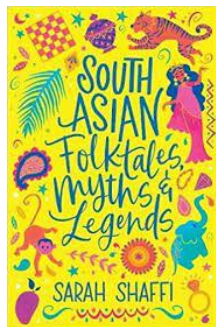
## Reading for Pleasure Matters at Hunters Hall

Here are Mrs Hearty's recommendations:



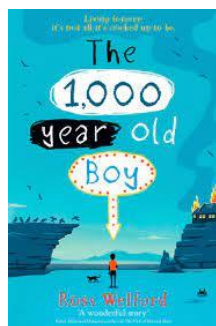
### Reading interest: 4-8
